



ADOPT-A-SPOT FACT SHEET

The City of Los Angeles, Board of Public Works, Office of Community Beautification (OCB), is sponsoring an Adopt-A-Spot program which encourages individuals, groups and businesses to take an active role in beautifying and maintaining their neighborhoods. Under the program, an individual or a group of volunteers may select an unsightly area such as a graffitied wall or littered sidewalk and agree to maintain it graffiti or litter-free.

OCB will facilitate the adoption of these areas by providing the necessary permission in the case of City property, waiver forms for private property, and instructions on the appropriate maintenance procedures. OCB will also furnish the supplies needed to maintain the area. Supplies include paint, rollers, rakes, brooms, shovels, trash bags, and etc.
